


Regional Talent Engines

What we offer

The programme will run in two phases. Those accepted onto phase one will receive training and 1-2-1 support. They will then pitch their plan and next steps to a judging panel for selection to phase two. Those accepted onto phase two will receive:

- Equity free funding of £20,000 towards living and business support costs
- Expert mentoring
- Training, roundtables, and events
- 1-2-1 coaching
- Access to our co-working and meeting space, the Taylor Centre, in central London.

Places on the programme are awarded without charge. We do not charge fees or take equity.

Who is eligible to apply

- Recent leavers from Further Education colleges (graduated since September 2016) who have achieved a technical qualification (engineering or related subject) at levels 3-5
- Mid- or later- career engineers or technologists who have been working in skills jobs and are seeking a career change as an entrepreneur.
